A New Square rabbi accused of sexually abusing a child multiple times pleaded not guilty in Rockland County Court today.

Rabbi Moshe Menachem Taubenfeld, 55, pleaded not guilty to charges that he sexually abused a boy repeatedly from September 2001 until May 2006.

Taubenfeld's accuser, who spoke to News 12 using the name 'Laiby,' says he turned to the rabbi for counseling after the attacks...
