

# Man Gets 3 Years in Sex Case

A 37-year-old man was sentenced to three years in prison yesterday for unlawfully transporting two girls from Brooklyn to a New Jersey motel for sex. The defendant, Victor Einhorn, pleaded guilty in February to two Federal charges of unlawfully transporting minors - aged 11 and 12 - across state lines to engage in unlawful sexual activity. Judge Edward R. Korman of United States District Court in Brooklyn also sentenced Mr. Einhorn to five years probation.

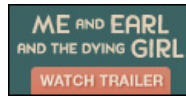

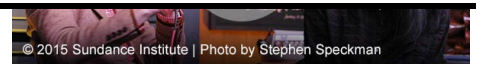
