## Metro Datelines; U.S. Jury Indicts Man In Youth-Sex Case

**BROOKLYN**— A bus company manager was indicted yesterday on Federal charges of unlawfully transporting two young girls to New Jersey to engage in prostitution, the authorities said.

The defendant, Victor Einhorn, 36 years old, was arrested last July 7 at a motel in Fort Lee, N.J., and charged with sexual assault and aggravated sexual assault. He was released on \$75,000 bail.

The Federal indictment charges that Mr. Einhorn took the girls, 12 and 13 years old, from Brooklyn to a New Jersey motel six times between May and July. An assistant Bergen County prosecutor, Fred Schwanwee, said Mr. Einhorn gave the girls \$20 to \$30 several times.

Mr. Einhorn, of Monsey, N.Y., and Brooklyn, manages the Private Trails Bus Company of Brooklyn, the authorities said.

He is charged with 12 counts of unlawfully transporting minors for the purpose of engaging in prostitution and other unlawful sexual activity. If convicted on all counts, he would face a maximum of 120 years in jail and a \$3 million fine. He is to be arraigned today in Brooklyn. (AP)

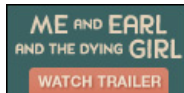
