Jersey man arrested for forcible touching at nursing home

TOWN OF RAMAPO – A New Jersey man has been arrested and charged with forcible touching following an incident at the Northern Metropolitan Nursing Home in Ramapo.

Police allege Abraham Mashinsky, 23, of Lakewood, New Jersey, was staying with his father when on Thursday night, he engaged a 31-year-old female resident in conversation and later forcibly touched her. When confronted by staff, he left the building and police could not locate him.

On Friday night while continuing their investigation, the police officer on post recognized Mashinsky and apprehended him. He was arraigned and released on his own recognizance pending a future court appearance. An order of protection was also issued for him to stay away from the victim.
