A serious indictment was filed against Baruch Ganz (22) of Ashdod for serious acts committed by a 6-year-old girl in Bnei Brak, as was extensively covered in B'hadrei Haredim. Ganz has already admitted to assaulting eight other girls



A serious indictment was filed against Baruch Gantz (22) of Ashdod for serious acts he committed on a 6-year-old girl in Bnei Brak, as was extensively covered in B'hadrei Haredim.

A week after Gantz was arrested by the Dan District Police, and after admitting nine incidents of assault on girls "only up to the age of 8," he was indicted and his detention extended until a different decision was made.

According to the indictment, last Sunday, a 6-year-old girl went alone from her home to her kindergarten in Bnei Brak. At the same time, Ganz was alone in his grandmother's home in Bnei Brak and looked out the window at the street outside the apartment. On her way to kindergarten, the minor moved near the building where the apartment is located.

When Ganz notices the girl, he calls out to her, "Girl, come upstairs." The defendant went down to the yard of the building and when he noticed her, he told her to go upstairs with him and she joined him. When they entered the apartment, the defendant sat down on a sofa in the living room, asked the girl what garden she was studying and the two of them talked. As he sits on the couch and the minor stands in front of him, he commits serious offenses while telling her, "I'm making fun of you, I'm tickling you."

Later, he asked her to accompany him to the bathroom where he continued to commit serious acts. The girl told him that "it is forbidden in the Torah" and that she should go to the kindergarten and leave the apartment.

The next morning the girl made her way home from kindergarten and Gantz called her back upstairs. She asked Gantz, "Yes, come." She went up to the apartment and told him that she was rushing to kindergarten but he again committed grave and forbidden acts while telling her, "You have beautiful stockings."

At first, his relative, an ultra-Orthodox lawyer, was arrested, but after the investigators realized he was not connected he was released, but not Penny who visited the apartment with them. During their stay, the interrogators noticed the hat, and the interrogators answered that it belonged to a relative of his family who lived in the apartment. The interrogators summoned him for interrogation, where he admitted nine cases of child abuse, noting that the girls were "only up to the age of 8 and no more."

Today, with the filing of the indictment, the Central District Prosecutor's Office filed a request for his detention until the end of legal proceedings against him.
