The suspect student who assaulted the minor will remain in detention

The detention of David Avi, head of Bnei Brak, who was suspected of hitting a 7-year-old girl in a toy store about a month ago, has been extended for the second time

For the second time, the arrest of David Avi, head of Bnei Brak, who is suspected of publicly assaulting a minor.

The Tel Aviv Magistrate's Court extended for the second time the detention of David Avi-Rosh, 22, of Bnei Brak, who was arrested on Thursday night on suspicion of assaulting a 7-year-old girl in a toy store on Yitzhak Nafha Street in the city.

The suspect's lawyer, Attorney Moshe Morgenstern, agreed to the arrest of David Avi by Wednesday, provided that by that date will be filed against a prosecutor Statement Towards an indictment.

Judge Iron Gt noted that inspect the evidence shows that "there is a reasonable suspicion against the suspect offenses attributed to him ", adding that since the extension of detention on Friday carried out a number of investigative actions strengthened the reasonable suspicion.

In its decision acceded to the judge at the request of the lawyer and remanded the David headaches until Wednesday at 12:00.

background:

A month ago, on July 18, 2016, a serious act was committed in a toy store on Yitzhak Nafha Street in Bnei Brak, when a 22-year-old boy was attacked and hit by a 7-year-old girl.

The security cameras' documentation of the attacker's face was published on Channel 2. On Thursday night, police arrived at the suspect's house in the Pardes Katz neighborhood and arrested him.

The suspect was taken for questioning by the Dan Region Police and he was brought to court - where his detention was extended at the request of the police until today. As stated, today the court extended his remand until Wednesday, when the lawyer requests that a statement of the plaintiff be filed until then.
