

May 2013 Case Summaries

State v. Stanley Alspektor (12-1-04832-7):

On September 17, 2012, Alspektor was charged with one count of **Child Molestation in the First Degree**

(<http://apps.leg.wa.gov/rcw/default.aspx?cite=9A.44.083>) after it was reported to the Snoqualmie Police Department that

he had touched the genitals and buttocks of an 8 year-old acquaintance who was staying at Alspektor's

home. When interviewed by investigators, Alspektor admitted to the crime.

On April 1, 2013, Alspektor pled

guilty as charged, and on May 3, 2013, he was sentenced to 51 months in prison. This case took

approximately 7.5 months to reach a resolution, with 8 **continuances**
