

# Cambridge therapist loses license in sex misconduct case

The Massachusetts medical board has permanently revoked the license of a Cambridge psychiatrist for engaging in an eight-year sexual relationship with a patient while also treating her male lover and her two children.

In unusually harsh language, the state board chastised Dr. Joel H. Feigon, 60, for "inexcusable" conduct in the tangled relationships he developed with the two unidentified patients, who are therapists themselves.

In its decision, obtained by the Globe yesterday, the board said it was "especially distressed" by Feigon's "failure to exhibit self-control and restraint where his conduct significantly impacted and manipulated the lives of four patients, two of whom were apparently minors. ...
